Notification of schooling in another country

The City of Solna (Solna stad) has an obligation to ensure that children of school age living in Solna attend compulsory school or compulsory school for pupils with learning disabilities.

Your child/children is/are registered in the population register for Solna. We have information that your child/children is/are abroad, and we would like you to provide us with information about your child's/children's schooling.

Please give us the following details:

- Certificate from the school where your child/children is/are enrolled The certificate must show:
 - Your child's/children's name(s) and personal identity number(s)
 - The name of the school
 - The school's address and the city and country where it is located
 - Year
 - Date of enrolment
 - Planned leaving date

The certificate must be written on paper with the school's logotype.

School attendance regulations

The regulations concerning compulsory school attendance can be found in Chapter 7 Sections 1– 23 of the Swedish Education Act (SFS 2010:800). Children resident in Sweden are obliged to attend school. However, compulsory school attendance does not apply to children permanently resident outside Sweden (Section 2). School attendance becomes compulsory the autumn term of the calendar year in which the child turns six (Section 10). Obligation to attend school normally ceases at the end of year 9 of 9-year compulsory school or compulsory school for pupils with learning disabilities (Section 12). Patents/guardians of a child of compulsory school age must ensure that the child completes his/her compulsory schooling (Section 20). The City of Solna (the home municipality) is to ensure that children of compulsory school age who do not attend its compulsory schools or compulsory schools for pupils with learning disabilities receive the required education in some other way (Section 21).
